

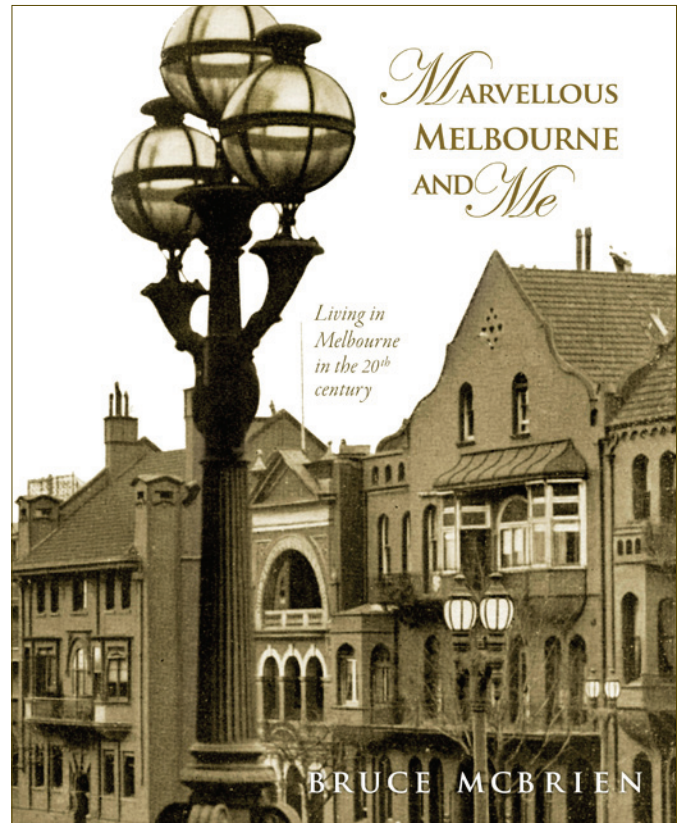
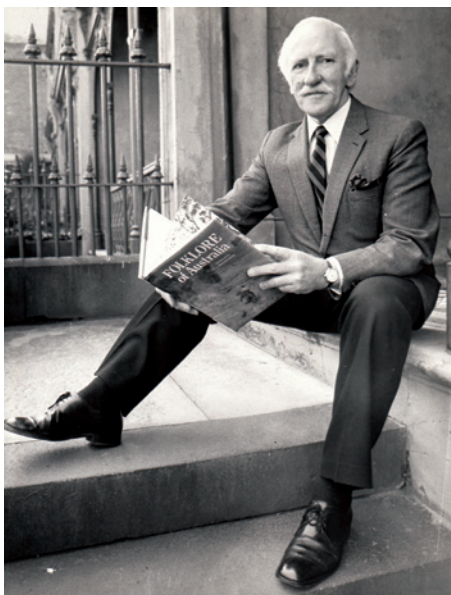
# MARVELLOUS MELBOURNE AND ME
